

Deaf Education

Students should consult the Undergraduate Catalog for information concerning degree requirements.



Major Requirements:

- A minimum of 34 semester hours of CSD coursework is required (22 upper-division and 12 lower-division). No more than 42 hours of CSD coursework may be counted towards the degree.
- To enroll in Upper-division College of Communication Courses, students must have an overall GPA of at least 2.25 and a 2.0 GPA in all College of Communication courses.

What I should know about CSD:

- CSD 360M ONLY offered in the spring semester of odd years (Spring 2017, Spring 2019, Spring 2021 etc.).
- CSD 175N Deaf Education Seminar (or CSD 175K Symposium on Deafness (retired)) Only 4 hours may count toward the CSD degree.

- No course in the Moody College may be taken pass/fail, unless it is offered only on that basis.
- You must earn a grade of C or better in your Communication courses in order for them to count toward the degree requirements.
- A grade of C- will not count in Communication courses. A C- is worth 1.67 grade points and a 2.0 COM GPA is required.

Deaf Education Internship experience:

CSD 364 and CSD 331E must be taken concurrently.

- CSD 331E and EDC 331 may not both be counted.
- CSD 364 and EDC 364 may not both be counted.

Offered in Spring of odd number years
