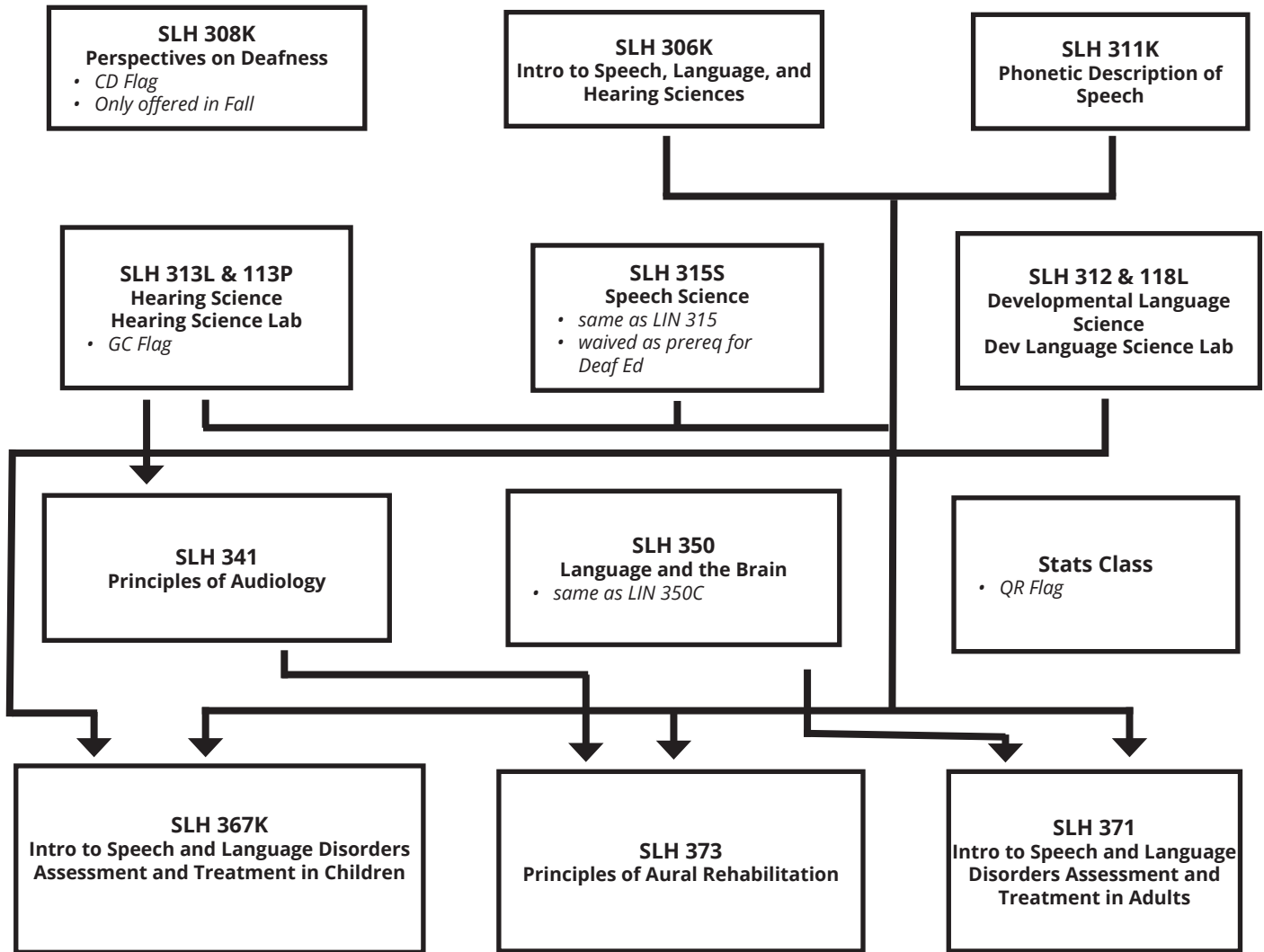
- At least 39 hours of SLH coursework must be taken (or 36 for students in the Deaf Education track), and no more than 54 hours of SLH coursework may be counted toward the degree.
- **No more than 60 hours of Communication coursework can count for degree credit.**
- A grade of C- or better is required in each course taken in the Moody College (some courses require a higher grade to advance in the degree), and no Communication course may be taken on a pass/fail basis unless it is only offered as pass/fail.
- Students must have a 2.0 overall GPA at UT and in Moody College coursework in order to graduate.
- Only 1 hour of Music Performance and 1 hour of PED coursework each may be counted toward a degree in the Moody College.
