Special Requirements:

- To enroll in upper-division College of Communication Courses, students must have an overall GPA of at least 2.25 and a 2.0 GPA in all College of Communication courses.
- CSD 175K Symposium on Deafness (retired) or **CSD 175N** Deaf Education Seminar - Only 4 hours may count toward the CSD degree.
- No College of Communication course may be taken on a pass/fail basis.
- You must earn a C grade or better in your Communication courses in order for them to count toward the degree requirements. A C- grade will not count in Communication courses. A C- is worth 1.67 grade points and a 2.0 COM GPA is required.
- CSD 360M** (Only offered in the Spring semester of odd years (Spring 2013, Spring 2015, Spring 2017 etc....) **Prerequisite:** CSD 308K or consent of instructor.
- Deaf Education/Deaf Studies field experience:
 - EDC 364** Internship (Only offered in the Spring semester of odd years)
 - EDC 331E** School Organization and Classroom Management - Deaf Education/Deaf Studies
 - EDC 331E and EDC 364 must be taken concurrently.
 - Prerequisite:** Completion of 72 semester hours of coursework, University grade point average of at least 2.5, CSD 308K, CSD 360M (concurrently), and completion of ASL 507 or level 2 (ASL 312k or level 3 preferred).
